

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

1. PLEASE stay and watch your skater as often as possible.
2. PLEASE read the Blue Handbook that you receive at Registration (this one).
3. PLEASE read the Figure Skating Bulletin Board at least once a week.
4. PLEASE be familiar with important dates. For example:
 - ✓ Special CanSkate Theme Days
 - ✓ Test Stream Test Dates
5. PLEASE talk to your child about their skating. Problems can be dealt with easier if they are dealt with promptly. Ask if they have anything for you in their skating bag such as a newsletter, Test Forms that must be returned, Competition Forms that must be returned or private lesson bills.
6. PLEASE be in control of your wards off the ice at all times. Noise out in the ice area will not be tolerated, as it is distracting to the skaters.

CHILDREN MUST NOT BE ALLOWED TO HANG ON THE GLASS OVER THE ICE SURFACE. PARENTS ARE ALSO NOT ALLOWED TO HANG OVER THE BOARDS TO SPEAK TO OR COACH THEIR SKATERS, AS THEIR LACK OF ATTENTION ON THE ICE could put them in danger of being run into.

Only N.C.C.P. level 1 coaches, hired by the club, are permitted to coach skaters on the ice.

IT IS THE POLICY OF THE DRAYTON & DISTRICT FIGURE SKATING CLUB THAT ALL SKATERS IN THE CANSKATE AND PRE-SCHOOL CANSKATE PROGRAMS HAVE A PARENT OR GUARDIAN IN ATTENDANCE AT ALL TIMES! IF IT IS NOT THE USUAL PARENT OR GUARDIAN, THE HEAD COACH OF THAT SESSION MUST BE NOTIFIED OF THE CHANGE.
