

PROGRAM ASSISTANTS

Program Assistants for the Preschool Canskate, and Mainstream Canskate will be volunteer skaters from the Club. They are choosing to put back into the Club what they have benefited from in their past skating and they generally have a strong interest in and commitment to teaching children their sport. They will be 12 years of age or older **or** will have passed their Preliminary Freeskate test. These skaters will be trained by the Professional Coach in charge of the Canskate Level before the program begins and the training will be on going as the season progresses. The P.A.s will also have helpers called Assistant P.A.s when necessary. They will have received the same training as the P.A.s but will not be in charge. If you have any concerns with the Canskate or Preschool programs **PLEASE** contact Kelly Culp, the head coach of that session, or the Canskate Chair for the club.

OFF SEASON SKATING

Given that our arena does not maintain an ice surface between April and September, some skaters may opt to skate off-season at another club. It is a Skate Canada regulation that these skaters must receive written approval from their home club for each session. Please discuss your request with your base coach, (she will help set goals for this period). Approval forms are available from the club test chairman. It is the skater's responsibility to ensure these documents are in place prior to out of club skating. Failure to have a proper letter of permission could result in Skate Canada voiding test results from outside our club.
