CANSKATE LEVEL CODE OF CONDUCT

We expect parents to go over these recommendations with their child(ren).

- 1. Skaters shall enter the ice surface for the purpose of skating lessons.
- 2. Skaters shall have a positive, attentive attitude and be willing to learn while at skating lessons.
- 3. If a skater kicks, spits or swears at a Coach, Program Assistant or other skater they will be sent off that session and the incident will be dealt after the session by the coach in charge. They cannot take time from the remainder of the membership to deal with bad behaviour during the session.
- 4. Every attempt will be made by the coach in charge and the CanSkate Chairperson to deal with any persisting behavioural problems, although prolonged repetitive issues may result in the skater being withdrawn from that session.
- 5. Only persons registered with SKATE CANADA are permitted on the ice surface. (This includes all skaters, coaches and designated Executive Members). Under no circumstances are parents allowed on the ice surface. **This is due to Insurance reasons.**
- 6. If a CanSkate parent has a concern with their skater's program, progress or Program Assistant, the proper procedure is to talk to the Coach in charge of the session or the Executive-appointed CanSkate Chairperson.
- 7. All CANSKATE participants must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet while on the ice.

PLEASE DO NOT APPROACH A PROGRAM ASSISTANT AS THEY ARE NOT EXPECTED OR TRAINED TO DEAL WITH PARENTS.
